22nd Annual Christmas Sprint Meet

(Under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules) Licence (TBC)

Saturday 2nd December 2017

General information and meet rules:

1. The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules.
2. All entrants must be a member of an affiliated club and an amateur as defined by ASA Law.
3. Age groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs, 15yrs&over. Competition ages will be as 3rd December 2016.
4. All events will be heat declared winners. Heats will be arranged according to submitted times.
5. This will be a CARDLESS MEET, ANY ERRORS MUST BE REPORTED TO THE ORGANISER AS SOON AS POSSIBLE TO ALLOW TIME TO AMEND THE PROGRAMME.
6. Withdrawals will be accepted by e-mail until Thursday 30th November at 6pm. No withdrawals will be accepted on the day.
7. Start sheets will be issued prior to commencement of the gala. LATE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.
8. Competitors must report to the competitive stewards at the starting control 2 events before the event they are competing in, at which time they will be allocated to their correct lane. Any competitor not reporting on time may be excluded from the event.
9. Awards will be presented to the first 6 swimmers in each age group. Top boy and top girl trophies will be awarded in each age group (including 9yrs) to the swimmer accumulating the most points over both sessions.
10. Presentations will not be made, competitors who have won an award must report to the trophy table when called by the announcer.
11. THERE ARE NO ADDITIONAL TOLERANCE TIMES, COMPETITORS WHO BREAK CUT OFF TIMES WILL NOT BE ELIGIBLE FOR THE 6 AWARDS BUT WILL RECEIVE SPEEDING TICKETS.
12. Coaches will be admitted to poolside on production of a coaches pass available on the day costing £10.50.
13. The referee's decision is final.
14. Swimmers are requested to use the changing room lockers.
15. No outdoor shoes must be worn on poolside; footwear must be worn outside the pool area.
16. No glass containers are permitted on the poolside.

17. You are advised not to leave clothes or equipment lying around as neither the promoters or Ponds Forge Management can accept liability for loss or damage. Any lost property should be taken to the announcers table.
18. The promoters reserve the right to refuse admission to any competitor or spectator.
19. Any matter not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the organisers. Any queries should be directed to meet organisers – the Committee.
20. All entries will be dealt with on a first come first serve basis.
